

Foundations & Practice: Early Communication, Language & Literacy (0–5 Years) 2 Part Series

Early language skills are the foundation for children’s literacy, thinking, and social-emotional development. This workshop helps educators recognise developmental strengths and challenges and provides practical strategies to create language-rich, engaging environments that support every child’s learning and wellbeing.

Part 1: “Awareness”

- This workshop builds educator awareness of how children’s early communication skills form the foundation for oral Language, literacy and learning.

Part 2: “Practice”

- This workshop builds on Part 1: Awareness, moving into practical application.

Sing, Move, Play, Learn: Using Music for Early Learning Success

This practical professional development workshop equips educators with the knowledge and tools to confidently use music to support children's engagement, emotional and attentional regulation, communication, social and motor development, as well as transitions and daily routines.

This workshop combines evidence-based insights into why music and rhythm work with music-based activities and experiences that can be embedded into the classroom to support learning and development.



- **Sing** to support communication, listening, and oral language development.
- **Move** to build motor skills, body awareness, coordination and self-regulation.
- **Play** to foster social skills, creativity, social skills and more.
- **Learn** early numeracy, literacy and key learning concepts through engaging, music-based activities.

DEVELOPMENT & INCLUSION

Understanding Neurodiversity in Early Childhood

This session supports educators to build a shared understanding of neurodiversity in early childhood. Educators will explore the many ways children may engage, communicate, regulate, and learn, and reflect on how developmental differences can present in everyday early learning environments. The focus is on understanding children's strengths and needs.

Educators will learn to:

- Understand neurodiversity as a natural part of human development
- Recognise a range of communication, sensory, social, and learning styles
- Reflect on how environments and expectations impact participation
- Use observation to better understand individual children

Supporting Diverse Learners Through Play and Learning

This practical session supports educators to apply inclusive strategies within everyday play, routines, and learning experiences. Educators will explore how to adapt activities, environments, and interactions to better support diverse learners.

Educators will learn to:

- Embed inclusive strategies into play-based learning
- Adjust routines, environments, and expectations to support participation
- Use strengths-based approaches to support regulation, engagement, and communication
- Plan learning experiences that are flexible and inclusive of all learners
